



Four structural steel Pods were fabricated off-site and internally lined with sandwich panel before being craned into position on site. Roof and wall cladding was then installed to blend harmoniously with the original award-winning building. Internally, sheet vinyl was applied to floors, walls and ceilings to form sterile laboratory conditions. Mechanical services were installed to comply with stringent requirements of the Australian Quarantine & Inspection Service.
