



Coleman & Fairburn successfully tendered two separate contracts to refurbish this heritage gaol building for IT Services. Internally the building was completely stripped and refurbished. Old gaol cells were converted into offices. Paint was removed from old sandstone walls to bring alive the heritage features. The building features new polished timber floors, glass partitions and doors, foyer reception area, office space, conference rooms, with new amenities and kitchen.
