



This site already contained an original church built in 1959 and a more recent and larger church built in 1979. Church growth required additional children's classrooms, storage area, and toilet amenities so a new extension was designed. Coleman & Fairburn were involved with cost planning and design details to keep costs within a tight budget. Coleman & Fairburn were contracted under a project management fee arrangement to build this extension. Construction involved some minor demolition around the original church and construction of a new complex over part of the existing car park. Careful planning and design allowed new covered walkways to tastefully interface and connect into existing structures.
