



This 1890's Heritage Building was in a dilapidated state with plaster and paint flaking from ceilings and walls, termite attack in the internal linings, joinery doors sagged. All doors were removed and stripped back to bare timber before panels were replaced and all joints reglued. Mismatched lining boards were replaced with sections that faithfully matched the heritage linings. The whole building was repainted inside and out.
