



This is the former Gatehouse of the School of Artillery on North Head. After careful restoration by Coleman & Fairburn it now has a new lease of life as the Gatehouse Visitor Centre to North Head Sanctuary. Restoration works undertaken included treating walls for rising damp, restoring old canite and battened ceilings, rectifying roof leaks, repointing the worst of eroded brickwork joints and beds, repairing and repolishing the timber strip floors, repairing or replacing timber panel doors.

The centre is staffed by Harbour Trust volunteers and features an exhibition on the history of the site, as well as information on the flora and fauna found in the Sanctuary Space. A very successful project!
