



Having built an outside Amphitheatre as part of the LaValla Centre, Coleman & Fairburn was awarded the job a few years later of converting the concrete tiered seats into a new enclosed Lecture Theatre.

A structural steel frame was erected over the Amphitheatre. External walls consist of brickwork, steel sheeting and pre-finished fibre cement cladding. Acoustic treatment to walls and ceiling enhance this new teaching space.
